Annual Scholarship Fund

The Redding Regional Chapter of Safari Club International is pleased to offer a **\$1,000.00** scholarship to a high school senior in the Redding region who enjoys the outdoors and plans to enroll in a 2 or 4-year college in natural resource management or related fields.

Seniors desiring to apply for this scholarship must provide the following information:

- Name, address, telephone number, present high school, and choice of college and field of study.
- Copy of high school transcripts with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- At least two letters of recommendation, including name, address and telephone number.
- Applicant must be entering a 2 or 4-year college and majoring in natural resource management, fish and game, forestry, gunsmithing or other related fields and provide proof of registration from the college of their choice before funds can be transferred.
- Copy of a current hunting license, or be enrolled in a Hunter Safety Course and present a copy of the certificate before the funds can be transferred.
- Applicant must be an outdoors minded person dedicated to wildlife and resource conservation, education and humanitarian services.
- Applicant must include, at least, a one-page essay titled, "What we need to do to protect our hunting rights and natural resources".
